**REQUIREMENTS** Two-dimensional drawing, painting, or mixed media piece ready to be hung (not free standing, no photography). Maximum size: 18" x 24"

**PRIZES** Up to \$20,000 in total scholarships will be awarded to the top artists, plus art supplies and long-term display at Baltimore City District Court, Eastside Courthouse.

All entrants must submit an entry form (**see reverse side**) with their submission. Artwork that meets the contest's requirements will be displayed on **April 4, 2019**, at a private exhibition at Baltimore City Community College. The artwork will then remain on public display until **April 12, 2019**.

The winning artwork will be reproduced and revealed at an awards reception on **May 15, 2019**, at the Eastside District Courthouse, where it will remain on display.
